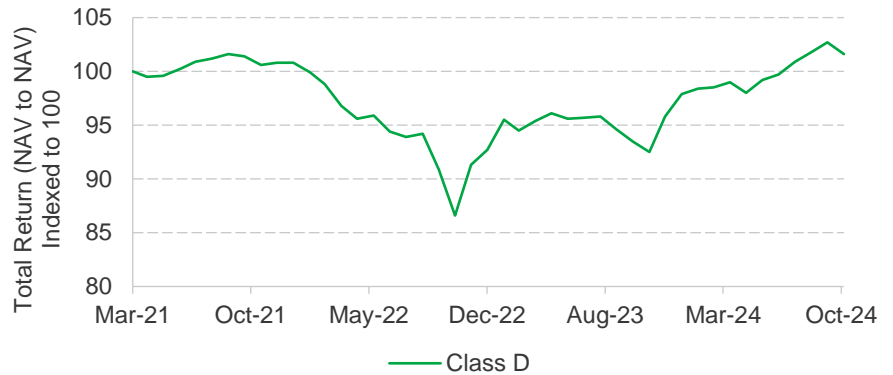
Investment Objective
