Manulife Global Fund - Global Climate Action Fund

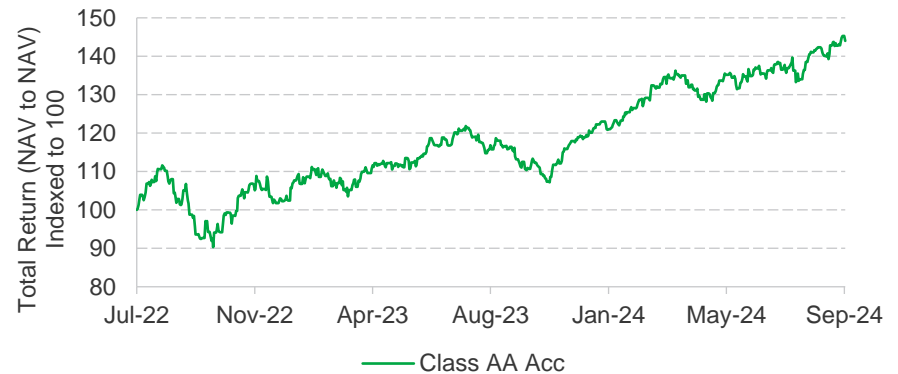
Investment Objective⁻
